DIEBOLD RELEASES FIRST HYPERCOM TERMINAL AVAILABLE FOR CS GOLD(r)

NORTH CANTON, Ohio - Diebold, Incorporated (NYSE: DBD) announced the release of the Hypercom(r) ICETM 6500 Point-of-Sale (POS) terminal, a small footprint POS terminal which offers a full range of payment options for colleges and universities. The ICE 6500 guides customers quickly through the payment process, offers off-line functionality as well as the ability for configuration at the host system with scheduled downloads to the device. The ICE 6500 is the first Hypercom terminal available for use with CS Gold(r).

"The inclusion of the ICE 6500 terminal builds on the success of Diebold Card Systems partnering with the best companies to offer POS devices that serve various niches on campus," said Mark Reinart, director, product management and marketing for Diebold's Card Systems Division.

ICE 6500 terminals can be used in a variety of places on and around college campuses, such as dining halls, convenience stores, concession stands and non-retail locations. The terminals also provide many features including touchscreens and multiple user-defined configurations, and they support meal plans, equivalencies, entitlements, stored-value credit transactions and student activity controls.

The terminals also present additional benefits to customers. The Milwaukee School of Engineering (MSOE) in Wisconsin purchased ICE 6500 terminals as part of its Diebold solution to provide cash registers with online ID card use in areas that were not complex enough to justify a PCX or Micros(r) Terminal.

"These terminals enabled simplified cashier training, quick and simple price and item changes, specific location identification for clerk and manager cards and easy-to-use touch screens," said Sheila Barber, campus card administrator, Milwaukee School of Engineering.

MSOE uses the terminals at the check-in desk, front office, juice bar and two concession stands in its new athletic and wellness facility, the Kern Center.

"These terminals facilitate membership sales and ice skate rentals, and monitor student attendance at athletic events, " said Barber. "Without these devices, we wouldn't have the current revenue processing procedure in place for the Kern Center."

Brigham Young University and Cornell University also use ICE 6500 terminals. According to Stephanie Hensler, senior product manager at Diebold, the units are a highly-anticipated product.

"We had 12 customers awaiting the release of these terminals," Hensler said. "The ICE 6500 is feature-rich without being a full-blown POS device."
